Playing the Note B



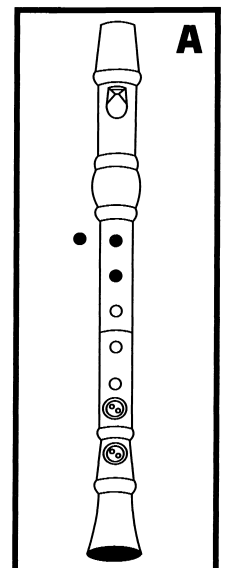
Speak the rhythm of the notes before playing each exercise.



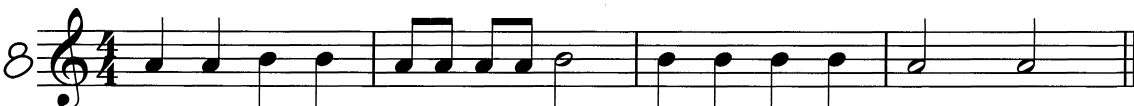
Playing the Note A



Remember to whisper the syllable "too" or "doo" for each note.

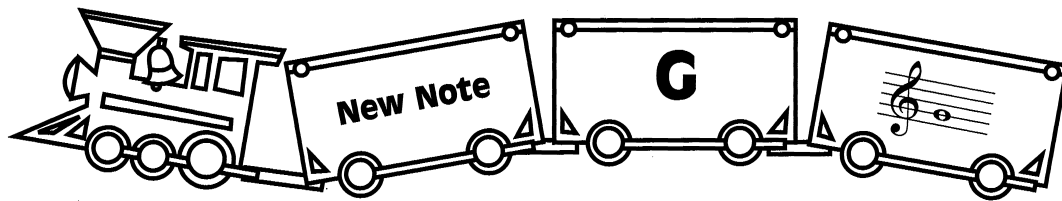


Playing B and A



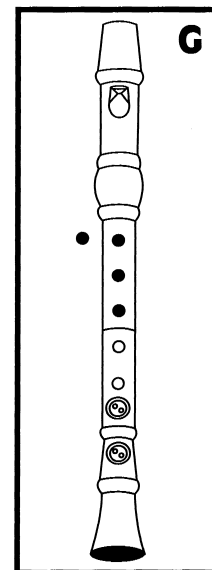

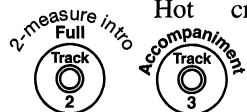
