During his lifetime, Chopin was probably best known for his waltzes. It is said that no musicale was considered complete without the performance of one or more of the brilliant *grand valses*. This short waltz, discovered only recently, is probably the simplest of Chopin's compositions in this form. It nevertheless bears the unmistakable stamp of Chopin's great genius for composing elegant, expressive melodies.

WALTZ IN A MINOR



The original manuscript of this beautiful piece was discovered only a few years ago. It is in the library of the Paris Conservatoire. Play it legato throughout, very slowly and with much expression.
