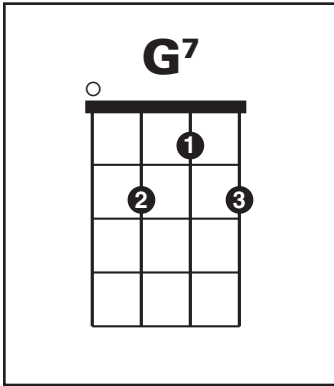

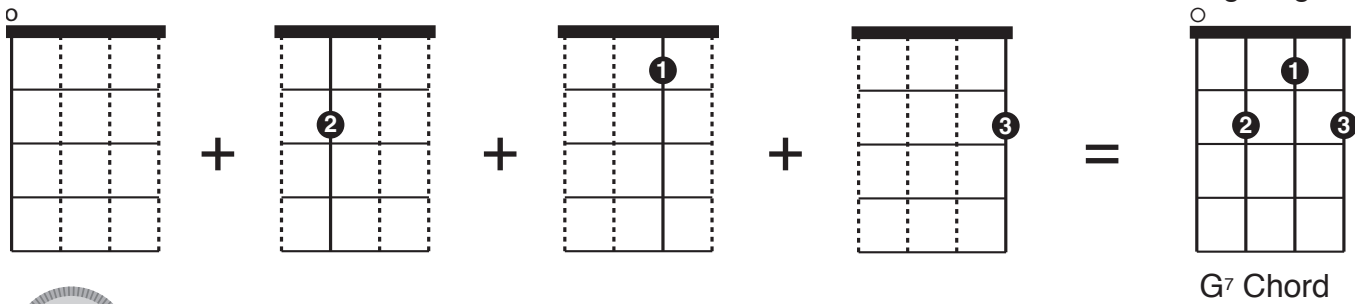


THE G7 CHORD

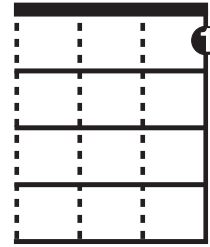
INTRODUCING B-FLAT

A *flat* ♭ lowers a note a half step. B♭ is played one fret lower than the note B. When a flat note appears in a measure, it is still flat until the end of that measure.
