### **PROGRAM NOTES**

There are four distinct modes when playing Minecraft, which has won numerous awards and sold over 54 million copies across all technology platforms. Its brilliance lies in the fact that players have no specific goals and are free to choose how to play the game. #### **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

The  $\frac{7}{4}$  section beginning at measure 84 to the end of the piece should be conducted as 3+4 (not 4+3).

#### NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
