ABOUT THE COMMISSIONING ENSEMBLE

The Maui Community Band was founded by Lisa Owen in February, 2003. Today, the band has over 50 members, ranging in age from 13 to 84, representing all walks of life. About one-third are students from local schools, with the remainder being adults who enjoy retaining their music reading and performance skills.

The band is proud of having seven band directors within its membership; of whom three serve as assistant conductors: Lance Jo, Ted Manzano, and Stephen Rodrigues.

The Maui Community Band is affiliated with the Arts Education for Children Group, which serves as a non-profit umbrella organization to the band. The group and its executive director, Bryant Neal, have commissioned several original works for the band, including *Silversword*.

ABOUT THE COMMISSIONING DIRECTOR

Recently retired from many years as a high school band director, Lisa Owen has been active in the Maui music scene for 25 years. She is currently the principal tubist of the Maui Pops Orchestra. In addition to the Maui Community Band, Lisa is the leader of several musical groups, including the Moonglow All-Star Swing Band, Maui Brass Ensemble, High Seas Dixieland Band, Village Musicians German Band, and Ragtime 3.

Lisa hails from Stockholm, Sweden and was educated there as well as in the United States. She has a B.A. from Thomas Edison University and has done post-graduate work at Southern Oregon University and Humboldt State University, where she served on the advisory board for the Humboldt State Brass Chamber Music workshops.

PROGRAM NOTES

While rehearsing the un-named work, many of the musicians pictured the haleakala silversword plant ('ahinahina) which grows exclusively on Maui's dormant volcano, Haleakala, at elevations above 6,900 feet. The silver colored plant begins its life cycle as a round, succulent-type bush growing on volcanic cinder, and is subject to freezing temperatures and high winds. The leaves, covered in silver hairs, have the ability to trap the heat of day so as to warm the plant at night. In 3 to 90 years, it produces a 4 to 6 foot sword-like stalk with up to 600 maroon flower heads that resemble the sunflower. Once it has bloomed, its life cycle ends. Because the haleakala silversword in many ways represents the uniqueness of Maui, this composition was named *Silversword*, and subtitled "Ahinahina o Maui."

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

If you have ever visited Maui, you have experienced the majestic mountains, powerful ocean, and possibly the barren and harsh landscape at the summit of our volcano, Haleakala. The first part of *Silversword* clearly depicts the majestic scenery that makes Maui a favorite destination for many vacationers. The opening and closing sections should be played with conviction and strength. The style completely changes at the $\frac{8}{8}$ section, which should be performed very light in an almost giddy fashion. It is a jig inspired by the playfulness of the sun reflecting upon gently lapping waves coming to rest on sandy beaches. At measure 66, the music depicts the afternoon winds increasing and bringing with them excitement and anticipation. The rallentando at measure 103 sets the tempo for the third section, which is slightly slower than the first. Here the composition reaches for the sky and finally blooms in triumph with the sounding of the timpani.
