Spirit of God, Abide with Me is a medley of two beloved traditional hymns that is appropriate for Pentecost, early Lent, or the general church year. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include Psalms 20, 57, and 104: 24-34, John 14: 8-17, 25-27, and Acts 2: 1-21. One basic homiletical theme is The Healing Spirit.

In rehearsal, strive for fluid 4-measure phrases with sensitive text declamation and a basic feeling of two pulses per measure. Rehearse m. 37-56 on a neutral syllable such as "noo" without accompaniment to improve ensemble balance and intonation.

Philip Kern is a composer, arranger, and pianist currently residing in Cincinnati. Frequently involved in professional musical theatre productions, he earned a B.A. in music education from Marian College in Indianapolis and a master's degree in fine arts (musical theatre) from New York University.
