By Candlelight is a stunning and elegant telling of the manger story, describing how beautiful that first Christmas night must have been as the events unfold in picturesque beauty "by candlelight." The gentle and lyrical music eabs and flows beautifully as it perfectly complements the lovely text.

In rehearsal, strive for smooth, fluid phrases that arch at the apex and connect seamlessly. Be sure to enunciate clearly so the words can be understood. Pay careful attention to the dynamic contrasts as the song begins softly, builds through the middle, and ends gently and reverently, leaving the listener with an extraordinary mental picture of the manger scene "by candlelight."
