PROGRAM NOTES

Following the fall of the Roman Empire, music in the medieval period (approximately 500–1400 AD) can generally be categorized into two types: sacred and secular. Much of the secular music was written by trouvères and troubadors, who were the composer/poets of the middle ages. *Medieval Dance* is based on the song “Amours, que porra devenir” (“O love, what will become of me”), which was written by trouvère Thibaut de Blason, probably around 1200 AD.

NOTE TO THE CONDUCTOR

Medieval Dance contains parts for six percussionists. The snare part is to be played either on a snare drum with the snares off, or any type of tom-tom. If you have more than six percussionists, you may double this part on as many drums as desired.

I hope you enjoy your musical journey back in time and find it a worthwhile experience.
