PROGRAM NOTES

The clarinet register key is often a curse in a young clarinet player's life. They play countless exercises to get the notes just right. This "bluesy" feature comes with a cost, as they have had to learn some new fingerings and techniques. Congratulations!

NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The purpose of this piece is to give the clarinets something fun to play while working on using the register key. The idea is to get the players comfortable with playing with the low fingerings, then adding the register key to produce the 12th partial on the horn. For example, if a clarinet player plays a low F below the staff and adds the register key, the note that should be produced is the third space C in the staff. Remember to fill the horn with air!

A fingering exercise for these notes is included in the score as well as the back of the clarinet part.

As always, feel free to adjust tempo and dynamics to suit your ensemble and performance venue. Best wishes for an educational performance!
