## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

*Red Clay* is a composition by the late, great jazz trumpeter Freddie Hubbard. Freddie first recorded this soul-influenced tune in 1970 for his recording bearing the same name. Since then, *Red Clay* has become a favorite of jazz musicians.

My arrangement opens with a melody based on the first six notes of Freddie's opening cadenza from the original recording. In this passage, alto and tenor saxophones along with trumpets present this melody while all others perform a contrasting bass line. Both parts should be equally balanced and cleanly articulated. In m. 9, the drums foreshadow the bass line much like the original recording. From mm. 9–20, piano, bass, and drums should agree on the *mezzo forte* dynamic level to maintain proper balance between the instruments. The 1st tenor saxophone and 2nd trumpet play the melody at the end of m. 20, and care should be taken to observe the printed articulations. The second time through m. 21, the alto saxophones, 2nd tenor saxophone, and 1st trombone accompany the melody and should not overpower the melody instruments. Measure 38 is another statement of the theme. However, in this instance, the altos and trumpets play the melody while the tenor and baritone saxophones and trombones accompany with a countermelody. Once again, accurate articulations and proper balance will result in a clean performance.

A solo section begins at m. 46 with a 2nd trumpet solo the first time and a 1st tenor saxophone solo the second time. While guide solos are provided, students should be encouraged to improvise over this chord sequence, which is a four-bar pattern (i.e., Cmi7/B $\flat$ mi7, E $\flat$ 7/A $\flat$ maj7/Dmi7( $\flat$ 5), G7( $\flat$ 9#5)). You may elect to open this section up for additional soloists as well. The background melody played at m. 53 (by baritone saxophone and trombones) and at m. 61 (by alto saxophones and trumpets 1/3/4) is a variation of the background figure that Freddie and saxophonist Joe Henderson play on the original recording accompanying Herbie Hancock's piano solo. Check out the original recording—you'll love it! Also, I suggest that you and the band listen to the demo recording of this chart at [alfred.com/downloads](http://alfred.com/downloads).

Measure 70 begins a development section that features the drums. For mm. 70–86, the drums solo between the figures as the horn section introduces more motifs. The drums can play the printed solo figures or improvise, but care must be taken by the player to play each of the figures. All players in the ensemble should gradually build this section dynamically so that they arrive at the *forte* together (m. 86 for alto/tenor saxes and guitar; m. 87 for others).

The "shout" chorus of the tune hits at m. 87. Here, the alto and tenor saxes, along with the guitar, present a melody inspired by the opening motif of the melody itself. The trumpets and trombones 1/3 have a rhythmic accompaniment figure, which is a variation of the background used by Freddie and Herbie behind Joe Henderson's solo on the original recording. Measure 97 begins with a quarter rest on beat 1 followed by an accented note on beat 2. The shout section should peak in volume and intensity at the end of m. 104.

I hope you and your students enjoy this arrangement of this wonderful tune!
