## **Moonlight Shadows**

This original work in Eminor is delightfully set to allow each section to play one or more of the melodies and includes a solo section. The opening statement of the "A" theme can be played by 1st violin and cello as a solo or soli. The "B" theme is presented by the celli at the end of measure 32 and is passed to the 1st violins in measure 40. Cellos and basses begin a restatement of the A theme at measure 49. The "C" theme is introduced by the 2nd violins and violas at measure 63. The piece should peak in volume and intensity from measures 87–94 during the restatement of the B theme. Beginning at measure 105, the piece should gradually slow down and get softer until the ending. I hope you and your students studying and performing *Moonlight Shadows*.

## NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
