**Festival Jubilate** is a joyous choral setting to combine the traditional Latin text *Jubilate Deo* (yoo-bee-LAH-teh DEH-aw: Sing joyfully to God) with English text adapted from Psalm 100:2,4:

Serve the cord with gladness; come before His Presence with singing.
Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise.
Give thanks to Him and bless His name.

Appropriate for school chor estivals and concerts, **Festival Jubilate** is also highly effective for worship throughout the year, especially for stewardship emphasis and Thanksgiving. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 100, Isaiah 351-2. Ephesians 5:17-21, 1 Corinthians 15:15-19, and James 5:13-18. One basic homiletical theme is singing prace for God's great goodness.

Patti Drennan, arned a Bachelor of Music Education degree at Oklahoma State University and a Masters of Music Education degree at the University of Oklahoma. She taught choral music for 28 years in Norman Public Schools—the first twenty years at West Mid-High School, where she was voted "Teacher of the Year," and eight years at Norman High School, where she directed four choirs that consistently received Superior (First Place) ratings. During that time she was awarded the coveted "Director of Distinction Award," given yearly by the Oklahoma Choral Directors Association. An active composer and arranger, Patti has over 400 choral octavos published with numerous major publishers. She has served as a clinician for school and church workshops in 20 states, four times in Canada, and has presented four sessions at the Texas Music Educators Convention. She has been guest director at numerous church "Composer Weekends." She has been an adjudicator for choral contests in Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Kansas. For almost 10 years, she served as Music and Worship Arts Director at First Baptist Church, Norman. She is married and has two grown children.
