NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This arrangement contains optional parts for hand percussion (tambourine and cowbell) and drumset, which can be used together or individually. The parts are written with playability in mind, especially the hand percussion, which is designed to be played by either young percussionists or string players. Have fun with this one!

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
