




Remember to stop the sound by lightly touching the strings with the side of your hand on each $\cline{\clinething}$. Wait one beat.

A note on the space above the staff is called G. Use finger 3 to press the 1st string at the 3rd fret. Use a downpick motion to play only the 1st string.
