

Give Thanks and Sing! Thanksgiving is my favorite time of year. I love everything about it. The leaves, the crisp air, Pumpkin Spice everything, family gatherings, great food - you get the picture. I also love the hymns of this season, though it seems there is rarely time to sing many of them. To that end, I've created this anthem. It combines three of the best loved Thanksgiving hymns and provides a time for the choir to shine as well as involving the congregation. I also added an optional brass and percussion ensemble. It is intentionally small in nature (2 trumpets, 2 trombones, percussion and timpani) to make it more accessible, while still creating a wonderful addition to the presentation of this anthem. In the words of David in Psalm 100, "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise." I hope this arrangement will be a blessing to your worship this season of Thanksgiving.
