In addition to being a student's introduction to performance music, other teachable moments in building musicianship present themselves. As a gateway to articulation and varying dynamics, the three most-commonly occurring articulation marks (staccato, accent, and tenuto) have been included, as have the middle three dynamic markings (mezzo piano, mezzo forte, and forte), building and declining in intensity.
