**How Great the Love of Jesus** - Sometimes when I think about what Jesus did for me, I'm overwhelmed with appreciation for the gift of His life. John 15:13 tells us that there is no greater love that anyone can show than to lay down their life for their friends.

This song is meant to remind us that the love Jesus showed for us is the greatest example of love, ever. Willingly, voluntarily, Jesus left the glory of heaven and His Father's presence to become a human; with every weakness and vulnerability that we endure. Almighty God was born a helpless infant, He learned and grew as a child, He apprenticed in a skill as a young adult. All the while, knowing He was destined to die a horrible death on Calvary to provide a way for us to be forgiven and spend eternity with Him.

As you prepare and present this song, think about the message of the words you are singing. Pay careful attention to the dynamics, the crescendos and diminuendos, the rallentandos and a tempost every musical expression will draw attention to the words and help the message come through to the listener. Pronounce the words very carefully and with good diction. You may have sung them dozens of times, but the listener only has one chance to understand what you are saying.

Above all, sing with heartfelt gratitude with intensity befitting the text even when the volume is soft. Build throughout the piece to the pickup to measure 60, where the volume is forte. From this apex, begin to come down in volume to the final statement (mezzo piano) of the poignant title.
