

Calypso Cradle Carol celebrates our Savior's birth in a joyful and reverent way by embellishing the music with rhythm instruments such as conga drum, claves, triangle and bass. The middle section serves as a bright counterpoint to the minor calypso style utilized throughout the rest of the piece.

Jill Gallina has achieved national prominence as one of the country's foremost composers of choral music. In addition to her chorals, Ms. Gallina has written over 50 musical plays for students in elementary, middle, junior and senior high schools with her husband Dr. Michael Gallina. In addition, Jill and Michael are recipients of the Stanley Austin Alumni Award from the College of New Jersey for their many accomplishments in the field of composition.

Jill received a B.A. degree in music from the College of New Jersey. She was an elementary school music teacher before becoming a full time composer.

Jill and Michael are inspiring teachers all across the English-speaking world with their music and educator workshops. Her chorals have sold millions of copies and their musical plays have thousands of performances across the globe each year. They are educating, enlightening and engaging students of today with their consummate talents and creativity.


