Band of Heroes An Interactive Musical Adventure

Erika Svanoe

This interactive musical adventure includes a narrative PowerPoint presentation that is coordinated with the music (website download information in the score). At three points in the story, the audience votes on which direction the story and music take as our “heroes” search for the Queen’s missing crown. The piece is inspired by interactive stories and text-based computer adventures popular in the 1980s as well as fairy tale and fantasy tropes.

Requirements

- The *Band of Heroes* PowerPoint presentation file—available at erikasvanoe.com/band-of-heroes
- Computer with PowerPoint
- A person to run the presentation during rehearsal and performance who can read music
- Projector
- Screen visible to audience and conductor
- Internet or SMS access in performance venue (optional—see Voting)
- Narrator (optional—see Narrator)

Instructions

MUSICAL ROAD MAP

This piece is a theme and variations where the middle variations can be performed in several possible orders. These are marked as circle 1, 2, and 3. Depending on what the audience chooses, the four possible paths in performance will be 1–2–3, 2–1–3, 1–3–2, or 2–3–1. The repeated “vamp” sections are included to give the audience time to vote. Conductors should repeat as needed and signal the gong and band for the last time through.

After these three variations have been performed, go to circle 4. At m. 171, the audience is asked what weapon they will choose: a sword or a whip. These are musically performed by a percussionist on an anvil and a whip. At the last time through m. 181, the percussionist will need a signal as to which instrument they should play for the remainder of the piece, based on the audience’s vote.

VOTING

There are several options when it comes to having the audience vote and choose the path of the story. Online or SMS voting takes some set up. There are several online polling sites and systems that can be integrated into the PowerPoint presentation. Audience members use their phones to visit a website or send text messages to input their votes. Instructions or a website address can be added to the opening slide of the powerpoint before the piece begins. An internet search of “audience polling PowerPoint” should yield useful results.

Non-electronic voting options include the audience holding up sheets of paper with an A or B on them, or holding up a number of fingers. These options may require brighter house lights as well as having the person running the PowerPoint make a judgement call about which option was voted on by the audience.

POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

A copy of the PowerPoint presentation is free for download at erikasvanoe.com/band-of-heroes. You may want to make alterations to the PowerPoint to incorporate voting, add the voting website address to the opening slide, or other creative adjustments as desired. Keep in mind that some slides are linked to others, and adding or deleting slides may interfere with these links.

A person who reads music will need to run the PowerPoint presentation during performance. It is recommended that this person also be available for a few rehearsals before the performance.

OPTIONAL NARRATOR

Though using the PowerPoint alone is the preferred method of performance, it is possible to perform *Band of Heroes* with narration instead of the PowerPoint presentation. For a narrator part and instructions for performance, visit erikasvanoe.com/band-of-heroes.

Notes for Conducting

Coordinating the musical road map with the audience choice takes a bit of practice. Getting used to signalling the band based on the poll results and remembering what to signal can be challenging. This is why having the person running the PowerPoint available for the last few rehearsals is recommended. Signalling variations with a number of fingers on the last time through the vamps works well. Signalling the percussionist about what instrument to play at the end might require different hand signals, or it may be possible to have the PowerPoint person signal the percussionist depending on sight lines. There may be some troubleshooting along the way depending on your set up.

Putting double-sided tabs on the four variations at circles 1, 2, 3, and 4 in the conductor score is recommended. You may be required to flip back and forth in your score during performance, and tabs will help with quick access. Placing the tempo and meter markings on these tabs is helpful.
