## PROGRAM NOTES

*At the Break of Dawn*, is a remembrance of the composer's time while living in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The idea came from a peaceful morning, sitting on the beach, watching the sun rise from the east over the Atlantic Ocean.

## NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The concept of the piece came from a request to write a lyrical piece for developing band that is not flute heavy. All flute parts are doubled in the 1st clarinet.

Please note that you may want to limit the number of players in the alto saxophone during measures 2 and 3, as well as 53 and 54, in order to balance with the flutes and oboes.

Simply put, the viewer is sitting on the beach while awaiting the sunrise over the Atlantic Ocean. There is a slight breeze with seagulls and birds flying through the air, hence the 16th notes and trills in the woodwinds. At measure 30, there is more activity on the beach with joggers and the ocean waves become more active. At measure 39, a cloud may come across the rising sun and cause a moment of reflection before the day begins. And finally, at measure 43, the sun is rising, and a new day has begun. From measure 52 to the end, the sun has risen, and we leave the beach to face a new day.

As always, feel free to adjust tempo and dynamics to suit your ensemble and performance venue.

I have enjoyed writing *At the Break of Dawn*. Best wishes for an inspiring performance!
