Combining two commonly taught folk songs, "Lightly Row" and "Song of the Wind," this delightful medley uses only the D string and the A string within the D major scale. Parts lie well on every instrument. The second violin and viola parts are doubled. Bass and cello are often in unison. Throughout the piece, all sections are often in rhythmic unison. This piece provides the perfect setting to reinforce *detaché*, *staccato*, and *pizzicato*. The songs in this medley will go together well!
