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NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Alone Together was composed by Arthur Schwartz with lyrics by Howard Dietz for the Broadway musical *Flying Colors*, which premiered in 1932. Since this time, the tune has become a favorite of musicians and has been recorded by Tony Bennett, Miles Davis, and Bill Evans, to name only a few. The song employs an AABA form with the first two A sections 14 bars in length, while the B and final A sections are eight bars in length, creating 44-bar form. For my arrangement, the introductory motif is added to the ends of each chorus (mm. 39–42, mm. 85–88, and mm. 135–146) as an extension of the form. The final statement of this motif (mm. 135–146) is extended and becomes a vamp to feature tenor 1.

The introduction begins with the bass, and the full ensemble joins in at mm. 4–5. At m. 5, the bass line is doubled in the baritone sax, bass trombone, and piano. If the musician playing the bass trombone part does not have the instrument to play this melodic line here and in the subsequent statements, the accented notes (A & B) can be played while the other notes are omitted. A small group of baritone sax, trumpet 2, trombone 1, guitar, and optional vibraphone state the A theme at m. 9 with a “two feel” in the rhythm section. A flugelhorn could be substituted in the trumpet 2 part from the beginning through m. 24. On the repeat of the m. 9 passage, care should be taken by the ensemble not to overshadow the small group. At m. 25, the rhythm section changes to a “four feel” with a brief return to the “two feel” at m. 33.

The solo section begins at m. 43 and has a chord change and a guide solo written in tenor 1. This chorus can be repeated as desired to feature other soloists. As with any solo passage, background figures throughout this chorus should complement the soloist without overpowering.

Measure 89 is a four-measure drum solo that can be played ad lib or just as four bars of time. Measure 93 starts the final chorus of the arrangement with a unison trombone section and bass soli. In this passage, attention to dynamics and accents will really make the lines swing! Beginning at m. 107, the ensemble should build the dynamics to the $\frac{1}{2}$ at m. 114, decrescendo in m. 117, and build back up to the $\frac{1}{2}$ in m. 119. The chart should have a dynamic peak at the end of m. 133. Tenor 1 finishes the melody of final chorus at m. 135 and then continues to solo until m. 146. This passage should build in intensity and peak again at m. 146.

I hope you and your students enjoy this arrangement of this great standard. Best wishes for a successful performance!
