A cute, pedagogically-based (get it?), first-year bass section feature, this piece will be fun and make your beginners sound fabulous. This piece is in first position for all players except basses. Basses shift up to C and D on the G string and only play pizzicato. Continuing Bob Phillips' tradition of bass section features, *Dance of the Bowless Basses* is sure to become an integral part of your standard repertoire.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The bass part is to be played pizzicato throughout. Several times the basses play a percussive sound (indicated by x noteheads) by tapping the top of the instrument with the finger pads of the right hand. There is enough time to reposition the hand for plucking. Have the bass players leave their left hand in position while tapping. The final note of the piece should be played *fff* by the basses.

In general, markings for fingerings, bowing patterns, and other items will only be marked with their initial appearance.
