NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Celebration was made very popular by the R&B funk band, Kool & the Gang.

Arranged in the rock style of the Kool & the Gang hit, this chart is easy to teach, learn, and perform. The Jazz Beginnings Series is scored for four saxes, two trumpets, two trombones, and four rhythm players, but will sound full with reduced instrumentation of three saxes, one trumpet, one trombone, piano, (electric) bass, and drumset. Additionally, optional parts are included to give more flexibility to the director, should the ensemble have different instrumentation needs.

I suggest studying the score to review the structure of the chart before the start of the rehearsal. Highlight the passages where individual sections or the entire ensemble are playing in unison or tutti.

Work with the wind players to make certain that everyone is using the same syllables when articulating. This will allow the ensemble to sound tight and improve the intonation. As a suggestion, staccatos should be played using the syllable "DIT"; accented notes "DA"; long notes with or without tenuto marking "DU"; and "DAHT" for marcato/rooftop accents. Regarding staccatos, play them short, but avoid playing them too short or clipped. Regarding dynamics, although the tune and this arrangement doesn't offer nuances, dynamics are always important to offer contrast.

To facilitate the rehearsal, rehearse the rhythm section first to make certain all the players are thinking and playing together, then add winds. The opening drum fill should be played with confidence to set up the groove for the band. Also, the drum solo in mm. 37–40 can be played as written or ad lib, but it should always maintain the style of the arrangement.

Also, consider having the ensemble listen to the original recording, and the Alfred Music promo demo available at alfred.com.

I know that this chart will be a fun piece for your young ensemble, and it will be well received by the audience.
