## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This piece was written about a life-altering experience over the last year. My personal life challenge has shaken me to my core and has shown me strengths and weaknesses I never believed I had. Humans have an overwhelming ability to overcome almost all obstacles.

As you can see, the tempo and expression markings tell the story. This piece should be approached as musically as possible. At M29, you may want to consider limiting the number of alto saxophones with the flute solo, as not to overpower the soloist. At M52, the ritardando to the end should be easy and flowing. As always, feel free to push and pull the tempo, musical lines, and melody as your ensemble allows.

To quote my friend for Bubbett, who is one of the dedicatees of this piece, "This is one of the great things about what we do, we can work through our issues by just... working. And in doing so, we share that small part of us with others in a way that they can join us in that expression. All of us have felt those emotions, maybe not in the same way, but we have all been there!"
