THE COMPOSER

Soon Hee Newbold is an internationally acclaimed composer and conductor known for incorporating differing cultural and ethnic styles in her writing inspired by her experiences and travel. She started her musical journey at the age of 5 on piano and violin at age 7 and performed as a concert artist in professional ensembles around the world.

As a composer, Ms. Newbold's works are performed by groups ranging in all levels from professional symphonies to beginning elementary ensembles in venues such as Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Center, Wolf Trap, Disney Hall, Lincoln Center, the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, and many more worldwide stages.

Ms. Newbold is frequently sought after as a keynote speaker and guest clinician. She has conducted and worked with orchestras and bands throughout the U.S. and overseas such as The Netherlands, Belgium, Australia, Indonesia, Singapore, and China. As a filmmaker and composer in Hollywood, her music can also be heard in film and other recording projects.

ABOUT THE MUSIC

Alis Volat Propriis (She Flies With Her Own Wings) was originally commissioned by the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra for the Merian Ensemble. The Merian Ensemble is a quintet consisting of symphony members Christina Smith (flute), Emily Brebach (oboe, English horn), Elisabeth Remy Johnson (harp), Marci Gurnow (clarinet, bass clarinet), and Jessica Oudin (viola). This ensemble showcases and celebrates great music by women writers. Along with traditional repertoire and performances, the Merian Ensemble gives outreach performances for students throughout Atlanta. They were featured on a TED Talk and numerous times on NPR's "Performance Today."

When I was looking for inspiration for this commission, I got many great ideas from Elisabeth and from our donor. They led me to some of the strong women in Shakespeare, poetry, contemporary writers, and legends. There were so many fascinating tales to draw from, I had a hard time picking just one. I came across the Latin saying "Alis Volat Propriis" which loosely translates in English to "she flies with her own wings" and thought it was the perfect sentiment. I also realized I had five incredible women in this ensemble that are a huge inspiration. Elisabeth was one of my best friends when we were both at Tanglewood as students. She was an amazing harpist even then and I'm still one of her biggest fans. The journey that all of the members have gone through in order to get to where they are is impressive and now they use their platform to generously give back in even more ways. What I love about this motto most is the reminder that we each have the ability to make a difference. Sometimes in the noisy chaos of society, it's easy to look to others to solve problems or wait on the world to make things "fair" when we really need to remember that we have our own wings too.

PERFORMANCE NOTES

Since it was originally written for a harp quintet, I wanted to leave the harp as an option in this string version. The piece can certainly be performed without harp though. In measure 42, if the performance is with strings only, this section should be played by the principal players or first desks of each of the parts. Strings should tacet if there is a harp present. Measure 49 pizzicato should be played as harp-like as possible, letting the notes be light and ring. Measure 73 is the contrasting section with short, accented notes. Make sure the melody lines come through especially in the viola. Keep the bow light but move it fast to get the power needed for the style.
