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## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

In many ways, the shuffle groove is the purest expression of swing. It is an infectious and joyful groove, and I have always loved it.

This chart requires the entire ensemble to commit to the triplet-based rhythmic feel for maximum effect. The horns should listen to the hi-hat and the snare drum pattern so they can line up the triplets properly.

We start with the trombone section, setting the tone with the main theme. Take charge here, trombones! Play this with spirit and drive. The dynamic is  $\text{mezzo-forte}$ , but make it an assertive  $\text{mezzo-forte}$ .

The rest of the ensemble joins in at m. 21. These parts all fit together like a puzzle, so listen closely to each section so that the combined rhythm is unified. In m. 29, the saxophones have off-beat figures to play and listening to the baritone sax and bass are important guidelines so that the off-beat notes aren't late.

The ensemble comes together at m. 57, leading to the sendoff to the solos in m. 64.

The open solo section can be repeated as many times as needed for any soloist in the band to enjoy. It's essentially blues changes with a twist.


After the solos, we enter the development section of the song, which is based on the two-note motive phrase in the main melody. This leads to individual solos for the saxes, trombones, and trumpets. Portions of these solos have no rhythm section so it's important for the horns to play with good, forward-moving time. Keep that groove going!

We build into the shout chorus at m. 138, and things should be popping from here to the end. But observe the internal dynamics, like the crescendo in mm. 148–149. The key change at m. 150 should feel like the high point of the chart, so give a little extra gas here and lift the audience out of their seats!

We slow way down for the ending, as the triplet drum feel in m. 173 leads us into the last chord. The trumpets have a "growl" articulation on their notes in mm. 176–177. Work on producing that growl effect, it's very effective!

I hope you have fun playing *Wise Up*.

Gordon Goodwin started composing at the age of three. No masterpieces at that time, but he kept at it and wrote his first big band chart at age 13. It was good enough to convince him that he could possibly keep doing this. Flash cut 20 years later and Gordon is working in Hollywood, writing for television and film, playing sessions on keyboards and woodwinds, and working with artists like Ray Charles, Christina Aguilera, Johnny Mathis, Toni Braxton, John Williams, Natalie Cole, David Foster, Sarah Vaughan, Mel Torme, Brian McKnight, and Quincy Jones, to name a few. Goodwin's cinematic scoring and orchestration craft can be heard on such films as *The Sorcerer's Apprentice*, *Escape to Witch Mountain*, *Get Smart*, *Glory Road*, *National Treasure*, *The Incredibles*, *Remember the Titans*, *Armageddon*, *The Majestic*, *Con Air*, *Gone In 60 Seconds*, *Enemy of the State*, *Star Trek Nemesis*, and even the classic cult film *Attack of the Killer Tomatoes*.

In 2000, Goodwin formed The Big Phat Band, an eighteen piece jazz ensemble, which quickly gained a reputation as one of the most exciting large jazz ensembles on the planet. To date, the BPB has released five records, *Swingin' For The Fences* (2000), *XXL* (2003), *The Phat Pack* (2006), *Act Your Age* (2008), and *That's How We Roll* (2011). The albums have featured state-of-the-art guest artists like Arturo Sandoval, Eddie Daniels, Take 6, Brian McKnight, Johnny Mathis, Michael Brecker, Dianne Reeves, David Sanborn, Chick Corea, Dave Grusin, Lee Ritenour, Patti Austin, Art Tatum, Dave Koz, Gerald Albright, and Marcus Miller.

Goodwin's work has garnered him three Emmy Awards and eleven Grammy® nominations, with three Grammy wins for his work on the Pixar film *The Incredibles* (2006) and his arrangements of "Rhapsody in Blue" (2012) and "On Green Dolphin Street" (2014). His charts are played all over the world, and along with his method books and CDs, have been a robust source of inspiration and learning for thousands of young musicians.
