

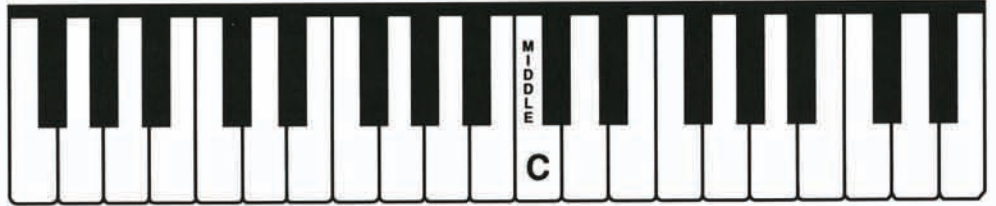
Primary Chords in C Major

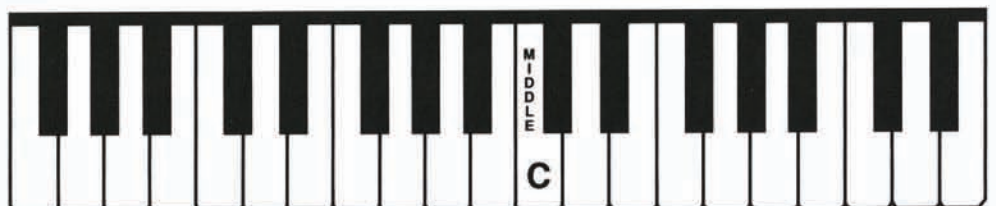
