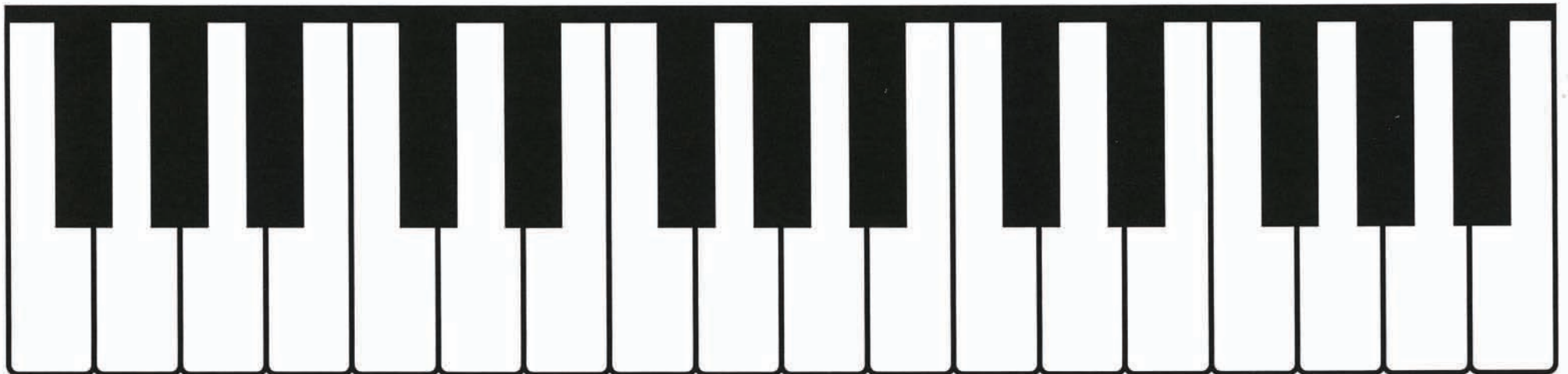
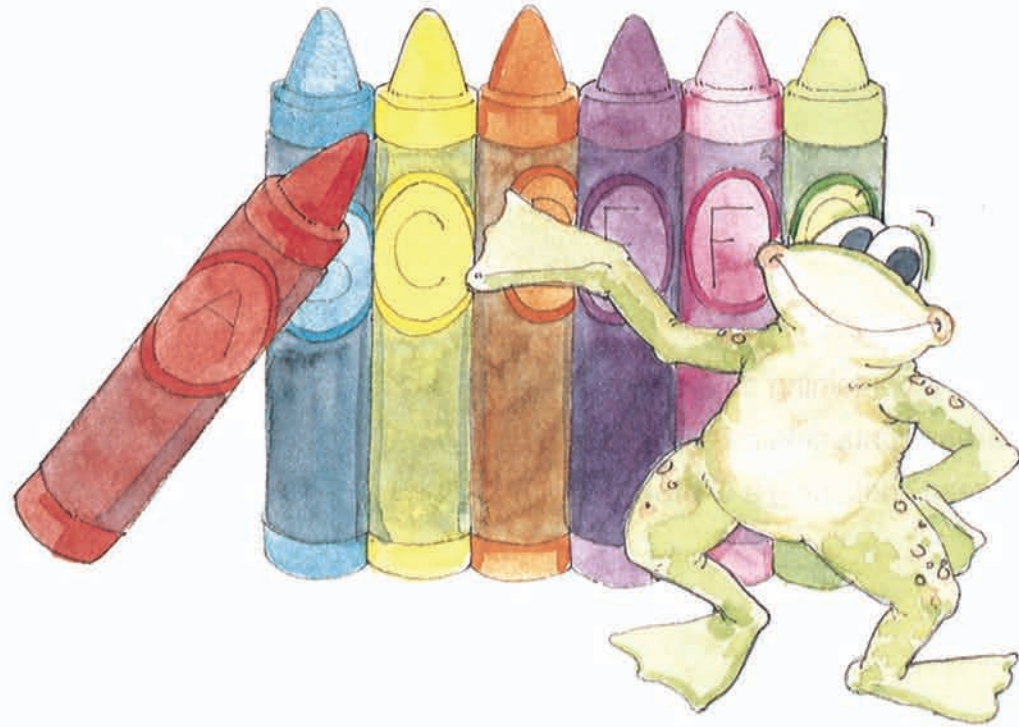


Coloring White Keys
