## **Crotchets or Quarter Notes**

A CROTCHET is BLACK and has a STEM. STEMS may point DOWN or UP.



A DOWN-STEM goes on the LEFT side of a note.


1. Trace these DOWN-STEMS.



BAR-LINES divide the music into equal BARS.

2. Draw DOWN-STEMS on these notes, and trace the BAR LINES.





- 3. How many crotchets are there in each of the above bars? -
- 4. Clap (or tap) ONCE for each of the above notes, counting "ONE" for each note.

## Playing in a New Position

The position shown below, with each hand playing C D E F G, is called C POSITION.

- 1. Draw a line from each note, straight up to the key it indicates.
- 2. Add the correct LH finger numbers under the notes with STEMS DOWN.
- 3. Add the correct RH finger numbers above the notes with STEMS UP.
