The mallet part should sound like the lighthouse bell signaling incoming ships. Use as many metalophones as available for the part marked - Bells, Chimes, etc. Handbells, Vibraphones, Energy Chimes, etc. all would be appropriate.

The challenge for a young band or ensemble will come with the long sustained qualities and the harmonic colors not often found in music written for this experience level. The adventure will come with the developing of quality phrasing, tone production and musicianship.
