GENERAL PROGRAM NOTES

Mars is the first movement of Gustav Holst's orchestral suite *"The Planets"* (1916). Although initially influenced by astrological factors, *Mars* was actually written to portray the horrible realities of warfare. Ironically, Holst finished his first sketch of *Mars* just days before Europe was plunged into World War I.
