## **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

The "off-stage" horn part is designed to imitate the sound of a fog horn.

The sound effects (as indicated by SFX) throughout can be produced in at least two ways:

- 1) Acoustic Using such instruments as a thundersheet, an ocean drum and a saxophone (to produce "sea gull" sounds).
- 2) Electronic These sound effects can be provided via electronic media: thunder, lightning and storm effects, as well as sound of the sea and sea gull calls. These should be available on sound effect CDs or the internet.
