## **PROGRAM NOTES**

"Hot Tamales" is a percussion feature for beginning band. Seven percussion parts are played by seven performers. Each performer has a two-measure ostinato introduced in pairs; then the collection of all the parts forms the rhythmical background for the piece. The individual percussion parts are very easy and can be performed by non-percussion players from the band if necessary. Generally, however, an elementary band has enough percussion performers to cover the parts.

I suggest rehearsing with the percussion performers prior to rehearsing with the entire band. The parts will fit into a groove, but a short rehearsal may be needed to obtain this musical feeling.

**Please note**: Our band and orchestra music is now being collated by an automatic high-speed system. The enclosed parts are now sorted by page count, rather than score order. We hope this will not present any difficulty for you in distributing the parts. Thank you for your understanding.
