PROGRAM NOTES

Russian composer Sergei Prokofiev lived from 1891 to 1953, and is known for works in all areas of musical composition. He composed the music for the motion picture "Lieutenant Kiji" and then adapted excerpts from the movie for a Symphonic Suite for Orchestra. This short excerpt from that suite is an example of his mastery of musical composition, with its angular melodic lines.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Volume levels can be adjusted to balance your ensemble. The pizzicato passages should not dominate the melodic line, but should be performed with rhythmic precision throughout. The tempo markings can be adjusted to the abilities of your ensemble.

The piece should have a bright and "cheery" sound, light in texture, but ending with a full and balanced sound.

The optional tambourine part will add to the spirited sound and can be performed by a non percussionist with minimal instruction.
