28. THE TELEGRAPH OPERATOR

The telegraph, developed in the late 1830s, was the only means of rapid communication until the invention of the telephone. Telegraph stations were miles apart, connected by long wires strung on poles. The telegraph transmitted electrical impulses in a code representing letters and numbers. Morse code, developed by one of the inventors, consisted of a series of *clicks* grouped into dots and dashes (short or long clicks).
