**LESSON 1**

1. Perform warm-ups to CD 1:8, “Ode to Joy.”
2. Practice lines 41–43 shadow-bowing and arco with their CD tracks. Practice the lines slowly at first until your bow and fingers match. Listen for the melody and match the pitches with your notes.
3. Tell your family the story of Beethoven and his *Symphony No. 9*.

1. Perform warm-ups to CD 1:8.
2. Practice lines 44–47 with their CD tracks. Practice lines 44 and 45 from memory.
3. Explain the structure of “Ode to Joy” to your family.
4. Perform “Ode to Joy” pizzicato and arco for your family. Use its CD accompaniment.
