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PROGRAM NOTE

Originally written in November, 1944, **Russian Christmas Music** was first performed in December of that year at a special concert in Denver, Colorado, by a select group of musicians from five of the leading Service Bands stationed in that area. Two years later, the music was revised and somewhat enlarged, and in this form was one of the three prize-winning works in the 1947 Columbia University contest for new, serious music for the symphonic band. First performances of this second version subsequently took place in 1948, the first by the Juilliard Band under Donald I. Moore, and the second by the Syracuse University Band under Harwood Simmons, to whom the work was dedicated.

The orchestral version is based on the final wind band version, which I prepared for publication in 1969, and which represented a thorough revision of the entire work in keeping with the developing instrumentation of the serious band or wind ensemble. This 1969 publication incorporated all of the many changes that had taken place in this area during the intervening twenty years. While the music remained essentially the same, the instrumentation was completely reworked throughout, to achieve even greater clarity of texture and the utmost sonority possible.

An ancient Russian Christmas carol ("Carol of the Little Russian Children"), together with a good deal of original material and some motivic elements derived from the liturgical music of the Eastern Orthodox Church, forms the basis for this musical impression of Old Russia during the jubilant Christmas season. Although cast in the form of a single continuous movement, four distinct sections may be easily recognized, originally sub-titled: Children's Carol, Antiphonal Chant, Village Song, and the closing Cathedral Chorus.

The publication of this orchestral setting of my **Russian Christmas Music**, some fifty years after its first performance as a work originally conceived in terms of the symphonic band, represents a high honor indeed, and one which few composers have enjoyed, to judge from the small number of works for wind band that have been successfully transcribed "backwards," so to speak, from band to orchestra rather than the other way around.

I am delighted to say that Clark McAlister's transcription of this music, made under my supervision, meets with my unqualified approval and recommendation as having entered so closely into the letter and spirit of the original scoring as to be, I truly believe, indistinguishable from my own approach, had I had the time and opportunity of preparing it myself, in response to Col. Arnald Gabriel's kind offer of a commission for making this music available to orchestras as well as the wind bands for which it was originally conceived.

I owe a debt of gratitude to both Col. Gabriel and Dr. McAlister for their belief and confidence in this work that no mere words of thanks can ever hope to repay, and I can only add that I trust this new version may enjoy a life at least as long as the original!

NOTE TO CONDUCTOR

The following notes were compiled by Ralph Satz, editor of the first published version of **Russian Christmas Music**. They apply equally to this orchestral version as to the original wind band version.

"This composition is based on the liturgical music of the Eastern Orthodox Church which is vocal in origin, no instruments of any kind being permitted in the Orthodox Service. Therefore, the entire score, no matter how fast the tempi or how powerful the climaxes, must be played in a lyrical style, with great sonority and sostenuto throughout."

"Tempo markings, and especially metronomic indications, must be taken as approximations only; the exact tempo at any point being determined, as always, by such matters as the size of the performing group, the ability of the players, and the acoustical conditions under which the performance is taking place."

"Special care should be taken with the long pedal points and the exceptional array of extra Percussion instruments in building up and receding from the various climaxes in the final section of the work. From measure 166 on, the gradual build in intensity must be properly drawn out and the peaks of sonority should not come as an anticlimax."

"The English Horn solos should be played "a piacere" (at will), however, without permitting an interruption of the melodic line."

"And, as always, care and attention to dynamics, phrasing, attack and sostenuto will be more than amply rewarded with a stirring performance of this exciting music."

With respect to the ~~orchestral~~ version, one can only add that the conductor should consider the printed bowings as suggested guides, to be modified as individual circumstances may require. These bowings do, however, reflect the composer's original phrasings, as far as the differences between ~~wind~~ and string technique will permit, so that any changes should similarly respect those phrasings.
