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## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This arrangement should have a nice bluesy feel with the eighth notes played with a swing feel. The phrasing should be smooth and lyrical at all times. In measure 13, the trumpets are in Harmon mutes and the trombones remain open. Trombones should be careful not to overpower the trumpets. There is a strong ensemble section at measure 35 that leads into an ab lib tenor solo at measure 41. The same thing happens again at measure 44. Measure 61 sets up the modulation. For the vocalist, this modulation looks harder that it is. It begins with the vocalist singing up a half step in measure 62 and again in measure 63. Observe the ritardando in measure 68. Measures 69 and 70 are played slower (rubato) and "a tempo" at measure 71 with a tasty tenor sax fill on the final chord.
