

Suggestions for Performance

Study is Good - Sing three times:

1. Voice I unison in Chinese
2. Voice I and Voice II in English
3. Voice I and Voice II in Chinese

Spring Morning - Sing twice:

Flute part may be sung as an obbligato on a neutral syllable (oo, ah, m, n, ng, etc.)

1. In Chinese
2. In English

Lullaby - Sing any variation of these:

1. Part I only in Chinese - 1st stanza
2. Part I only in English - 1st stanza
3. Part II only in English - 2nd stanza
4. Parts I and II in English - 1st stanza
5. Parts I and II in English - 2nd stanza

Performances in People's Republic of China and in the United States using mixed choruses enjoyed using men in one part and ladies on the other. A rich texture resulted in singing this in four parts. The final four measures need not be sung with each stanza.

Dragon Boat - Sing any variation of these:

1. Parts I and II in Chinese
2. Parts I and II in English

PINYIN (Pronunciation Guide)

An alphabetic system of pronunciation as used in China is practiced in America for the singing of these songs. If choral groups are fortunate enough to have present singers familiar with Mandarin, they will be able to discover the subtlety of sounds too complicated to list in this simple summary.
