

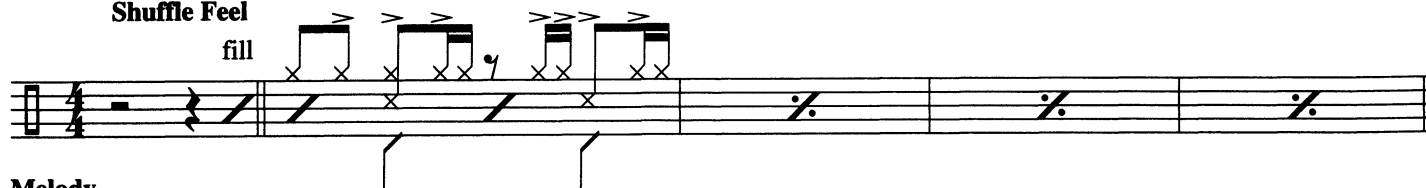

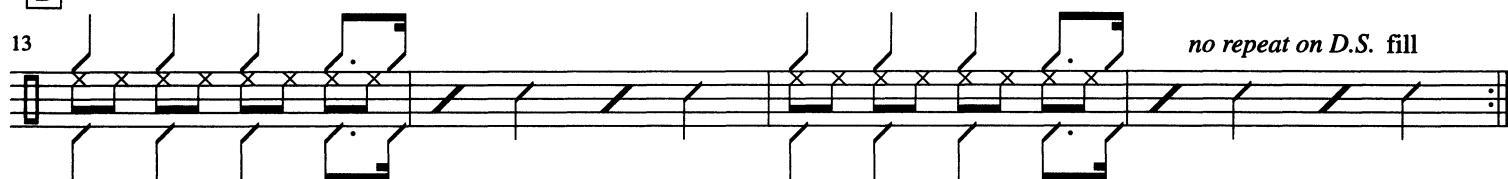

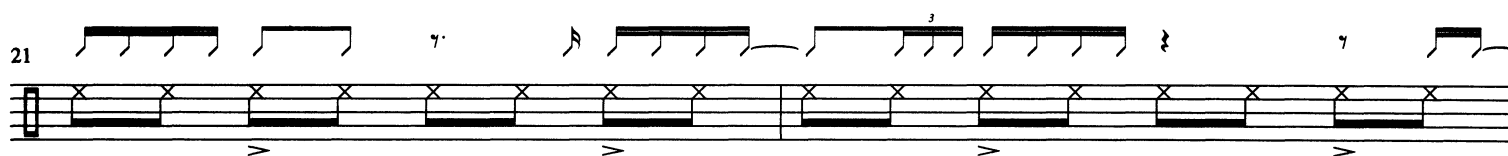
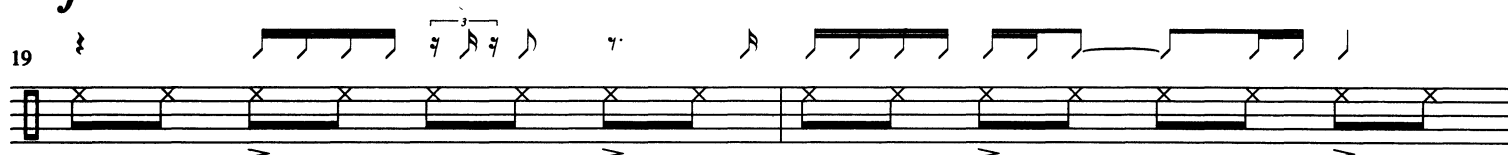
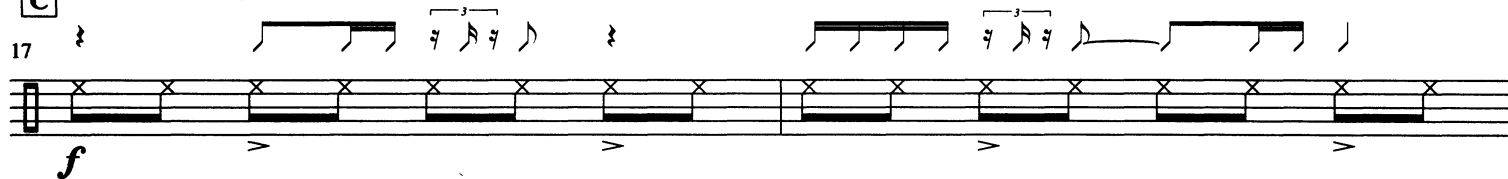

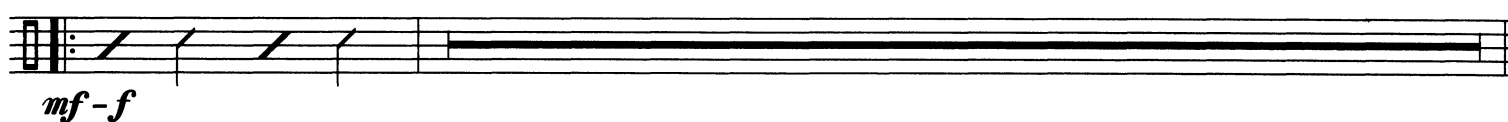


C Unison Melody (no bass)
