

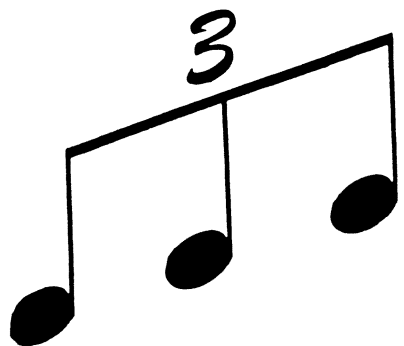


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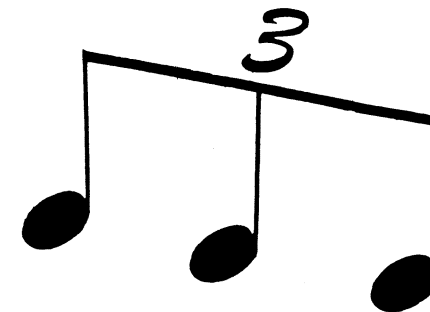
TEACHER: REGISTRATIONS

Triplets

A Triplet is a rhythm pattern of three notes receiving one beat when the $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, or $\frac{4}{4}$ Time or Meter Signature is used. For these Meter Signatures a Triplet of eighth notes is equal to one quarter note.

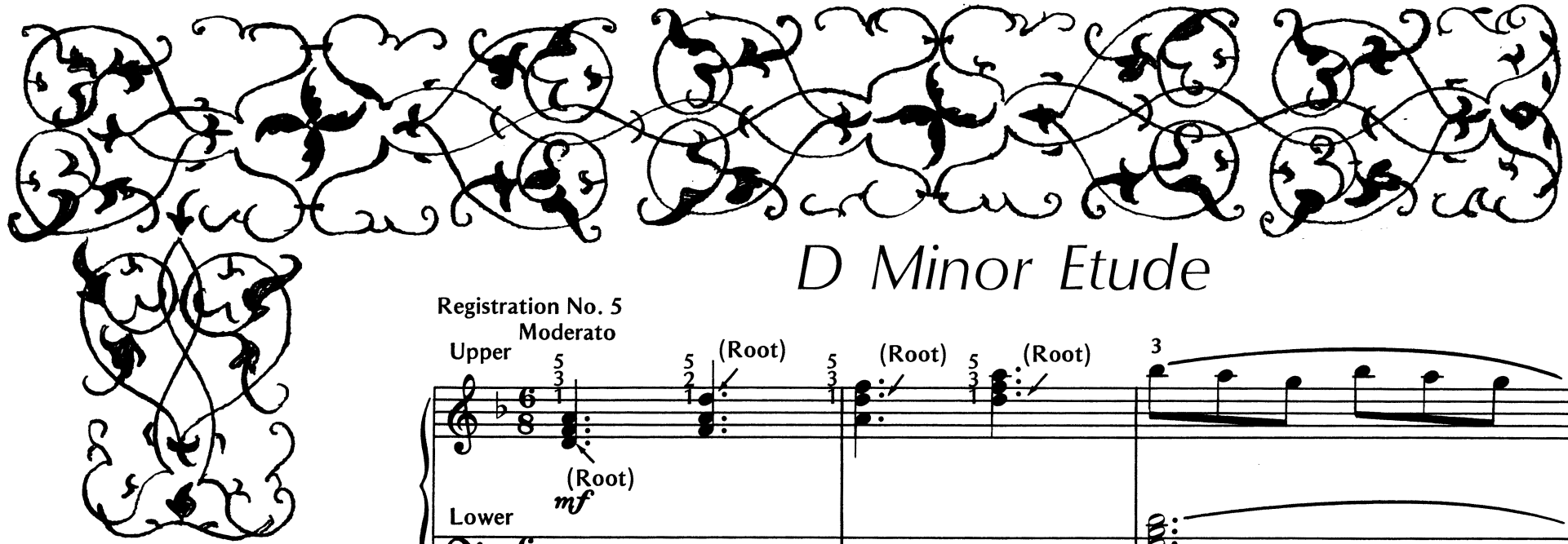

Minor Triads

A Minor Triad is a three note chord formed by playing the first, third and fifth notes of the Minor Scale.

Chord Inversions

The notes of a Triad in ROOT position are all line notes or all space notes. The ROOT or the name of the Triad is the lowest note. A Triad is INVERTED when the ROOT is on the top or in the middle.
