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Included amongst the music of the 19th century composer, Louis Lewandowski, are orchestral, choral and chamber music works. He arranged many old Hebrew melodies and played an important role in the reforming of the Hebrew service. It is difficult to find a more effective hymn of praise than this setting of Psalm 150.
