# Banana bubble gum

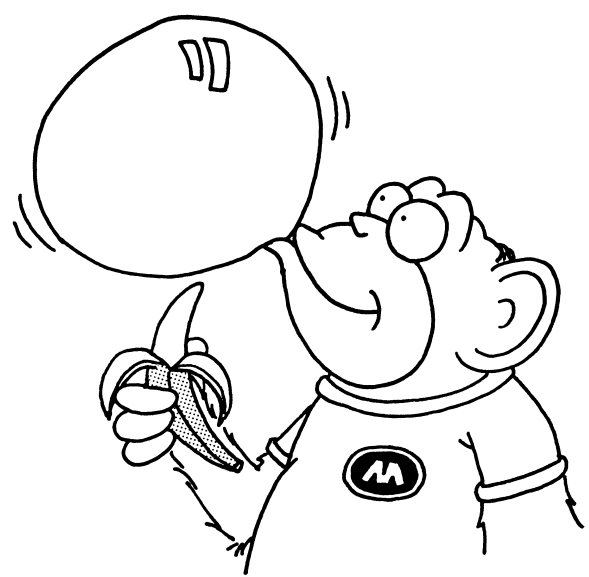
Play six times

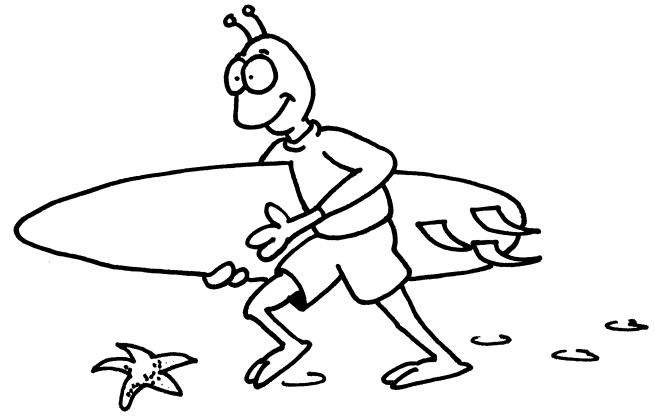
