
**Stringtastic Beginners** is an exciting collection of fun new compositions covering a wide range of styles. These pieces are carefully graded, taking the player on a journey from open strings to a D major scale. No more than one technique is introduced at a time and space is given for consolidation.

These books have been designed for maximum flexibility:

- Stringtastic Beginners for violin, viola, cello and double bass are fully integrated to work together in any combination ideal for use in individual lessons as well as group lessons, whole class teaching and string orchestras.
- The first nine tunes cover all of the rhythms used in the book, while building up bowing technique. The finger tunes can be learned once these rhythms are mastered.
- Many tunes have fun lyrics to sing, helping to develop a strong sense of pitch and rhythm. Learners can try writing their own lyrics, too!
- There are no dynamics in the string parts but players can add their own, once a confident sound has been developed; use the Stringtastic Beginners: Teacher's Accompaniment as a guide.
- This book is designed around the three fingering concepts: first position, fourth position and the basic D major scale fingering. Fingering is provided throughout to aid the beginner player; all is discretionary and flexible.
- For the first 20 tunes, part **A** is the **String**tastic part and part **B** is the **Scale**tastic part, the more advanced part which builds on the techniques covered in the tunes that follow. In total there are 63 different tunes to learn.
  - $oldsymbol{A}$  indicates the **String**tastic part  $oldsymbol{B}$  indicates the **Scale**tastic part
- Every tune has a fun backing track to play along to, as well as a piano-only backing track for practice:


