He is a member of ASCAP, Phi Mu Alpha, Phi Beta Mu and ASBDA, and is involved with the Ohio Music Education Association (serving on the executive board in 1995-1996). He is an adjudicator in the Midwest and a clinician for high school, junior high and elementary bands. He still lives in Cincinnati and spends a great deal of time composing and arranging for bands of all levels.

Program Notes

All Through the Night is an old Welsh folk song written down by harpist Edward Jones in 1784. The Welsh title is *Ar Hyd y Nos*. First published in Edward Jones' *Musical and Poetical Relics of the Welsh Bards* (1784), it has been performed by many over the years including Peter, Paul and Mary, Cyndi Lauper, Bing Crosby and Donna Summer.

Editor's Notes

Orchestral bowings and fingerings can be highly subjective and personal. The choices a string editor makes are designed to be pedagogically appropriate for specific grade levels while facilitating student musicality and honoring composer intent.
