PROGRAM NOTE

Allegro Appassionato in C-sharp minor, Op. 70 is a work for piano and orchestra by **Camille Saint-Saëns** (1835-1921). It is the second composition by the composer to be named as such, composed over ten years after his **Allegro Appassionato in B minor, Opus 43** for cello and orchestra. Completed in 1884, shortly following the premiere of his opera **Henry VIII**, it is performed in a single movement. A mysterious three note motif provides the opening material and frequently appears throughout the rest of the piece.
