PROGRAM NOTE

The well-known hymn **Nimm von uns, Herr, Du treuer Gott**, also set to music by J.S. Bach, was written by Martin Moller during a period of plague and was often used as a plea against God's anger. **Dietrich Buxtehude** (ca.1637-1707) set four of the verses of the chorale as a set of variations in E minor between 1675 and 1680.
