

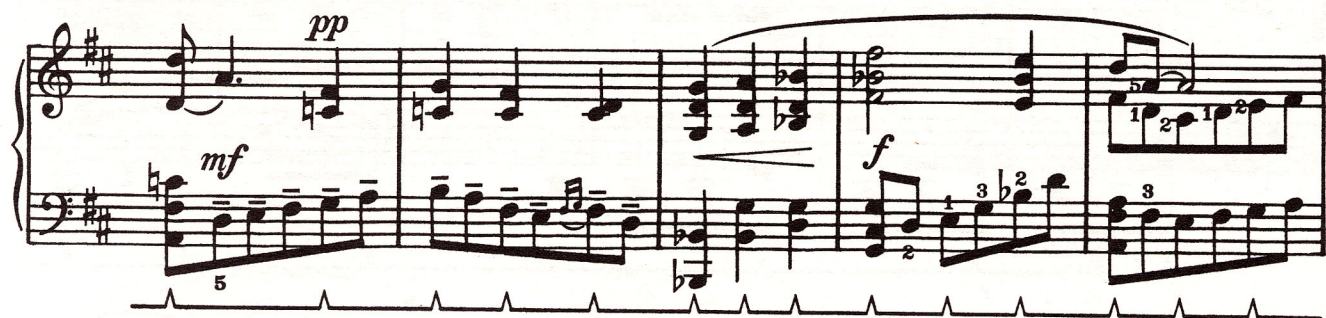
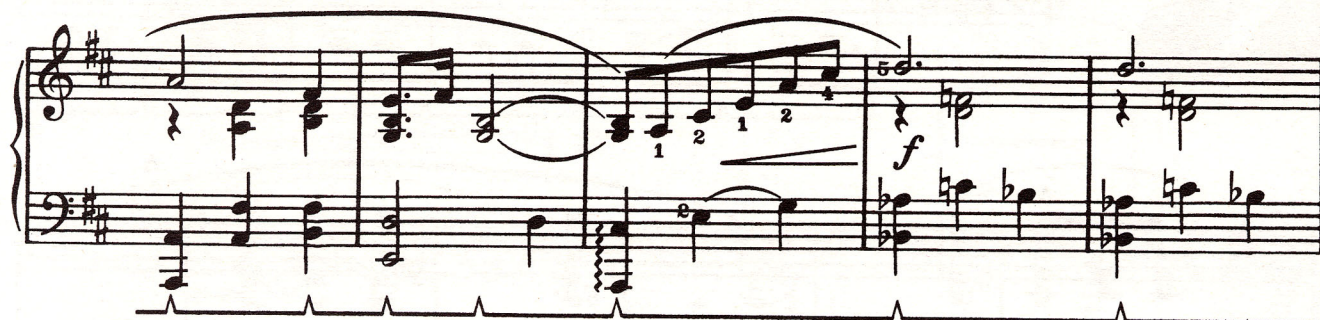
Love Song

On the day it opened in 1924, Samuel Barber enrolled at the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia. He was born in West Chester, Pennsylvania in 1910. A Pulitzer Traveling Scholarship and a Prix de Rome enabled him to continue his musical studies in Europe. His opera "Vanessa" (1958) and his *Piano Concerto* (1963) both received Pulitzer prizes. Barber devotes his time exclusively to composing.

The career of Howard Hanson is three-fold. He is famous as a composer, conductor and educator. He was born in Nebraska in 1896. Hanson received a Prix de Rome and Pulitzer Award in composition. A noteworthy aspect of his career was his position as director of the Eastman School of Music from 1924-1964. In this capacity, he inaugurated American Composers Concerts.
