Mozart (MO-tsart) composed this delightful tune in March, 1762, when he was six years old. As he played it, his father wrote the notes down on paper. When they were children, Mozart and his sister Nannerl played duets for kings and queens.



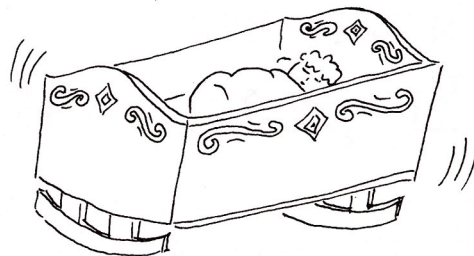
